Medina County Arts Council Announces \$4,500 in Grant Funding for Arts in Education

MEDINA, Ohio – The Medina County Arts Council is awarding grants for art-related projects in Medina County schools. While there is no funding limit on each grant we award, in the past we have awarded several grants of approximately \$400. Total available funds for arts education grants this year is \$4,500, and we will try to fund as many projects as possible within this budget. We can fund complete projects or partial if your project is beyond our scope.

Completed grant applications must be received by September 1st, 2023. The board will make a decision and vote on the grants during September for an October distribution of funds. Grant projects must be completed by May 31, 2024 and follow-up reports submitted by June 30, 2024.

Grant Funds MUST:

- * Benefit students through learning a discipline in the arts (performing, visual, or language)
- * Go beyond a routine lesson with substantive enrichment
- * Have a lesson objective with a learning goal for students
